STAFFING:

The Mental Health Department is just about fully staffed at this time with one position vacant that we will be posting in the near future. Our Carbon CASSP Coordinator is back from maternity leave and we will be having a TCM going out on maternity leave in the near future.

BUDGET:

PROVIDERS:

Concern and Scranton Counseling are now providing Family Based services. Concern is serving Carbon and Monroe Counties. Scranton Counseling is serving Pike and Monroe Counties.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

- **Administrative Case Management:**
Nothing new to report
- **Targeted Case Management:**
All three counties are open for referrals.
- **Forensic Case Management:**
We currently have 6 consumers waiting for admission to Norristown.
- **CASSP:**
There are 11 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 25 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There were 2 discharges and 1 recommendation.
- **CHIPP:**
There are currently 18 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH). There were 0 admissions, 0 discharges and 5 individuals are waiting for admission.
