MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT

**STAFFING:**

There are currently several vacant positions within the MH Department. In the TCM Department we have two Carbon vacancies, two Monroe vacancies, and one Pike vacancy. We have one Monroe TCM on maternity leave, due back in September 2018. Currently we have one vacant Pike/Monroe FCM position. We are interviewing for an MH Administrative Assistance.

**BUDGET:**

**PROVIDERS:**

Merakey will be announcing an open house for the 912 Main Street, Stroudsburg location.

**DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:**

- **Administrative Case Management:**  
Nothing new to report
- **Targeted Case Management:**  
Carbon is not accepting TCM referrals at this time. Monroe and Pike are continuing to accept referrals.
- **Forensic Case Management:**  
We currently have 6 individuals in Norristown and we have 4 consumers waiting for admission. The individuals have been on the wait list since 12/2017; 1/2018; 6/2018; and 7/2018.
- **CASSP:**  
There are 7 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 28 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 4 discharges and 3 recommendations in June.
- **CHIPP:**  
There are currently 23 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).  
There was 4 admissions, 1 diversion, 0 discharges and 0 individuals are on the waiting list.
