

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT
January 2019**

STAFFING:

In the TCM Department we have one vacancy in the Pike Office and we have two Carbon FCM vacancies. We are currently interviewing for the Director of Consumer Support Services position.

BUDGET:

No updates.

PROVIDERS:

No updates.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

- **Administrative Case Management:**

30 CMP Intakes in December 2018 / 14 CMP walk-ins

- **Targeted Case Management:**

29 CMP Intakes in December 2018

- **Forensic Department:**

28 CMP Intakes

We currently have 9 individuals in Norristown and we have 3 consumers officially on the wait list for admission. The individuals have been on the wait list since; 10/2018; 11/2018; and 11/2018.

Forensic Expansion: Project Transitions is moving forward with the creation of the SIL (Supported Independent Living Program) and the CRR (Community Residential Rehabilitation) programs. They are purchasing. These programs should be up and running by the end of the fiscal year.

RTF-A (Residential Treatment Facility – Adult): We are currently having meetings with the provider that put in a proposal to develop this program.

- **CASSP:**

There are 8 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 26 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 2 discharges and 2 recommendations for out of home placements.

The SOC (Systems of Care) Initiative in Carbon, Monroe, and Pike Counties through the PA Care Partnership is continuing to develop. Larissa Kimmel has been hired as the Systems of Care Coordinator.

- **CHIPP:**

There are currently 22 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).

There was 1 admissions, 0 diversions, 1 discharges and 2 individual are on the waiting list.
