MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT  
March 2019**

**STAFFING:**

In the TCM Department we have one vacancy in the Pike Office and one Carbon TCM on a leave. We just hired one FCM in Carbon and are currently interviewing for another FCM in Carbon. Jennifer Fuente has been promoted to the Community Outreach Coordinator position and Rhonda Wyler is now the ACM Supervisor.

**BUDGET:**

**PROVIDERS:**

Person Centered Services (PCS) will be ready for admissions in the next week for the Forensic SIL program. the Forensic CRR, located in Lansford, Carbon County is currently getting a few minor renovations and will be ready for admissions within the next 4 to 6 weeks.

Project Transitions continue to search for a location for the RTF-A (Residential Treatment Facility – Adult).

Preventive Measures has started a teen group this month which will be held on Thursdays from 6 to 7 PM @ 429 N. Courtland Street, East Stroudsburg, PA

RHD Street to Feet's 5 Year Anniversary Breakfast is on Friday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, from 8:30 to 10:30 AM at the East Stroudsburg United Methodist Church.

**DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:**

- **Administrative Case Management:**

3 CMP Intakes in February 2019 / 8 CMP walk-ins / 145 CMP Screening calls

- **Targeted Case Management:**

30 CMP Intakes in February 2019 and 18 discharges.

TCM Productivity is low, so we are discussing possible causes and brainstorming solutions.

Carbon TCM is closed to referrals as of 2/14/2019 with a projected opening of the end of March.

- **Forensic Department:**

20 CMP Intakes

We currently have 9 individuals in Norristown and 2 individuals are in Torrence as of 2/13/2019. We have 0 consumers on the wait list for admission. We have moved to utilizing Torrence State Hospital for forensic services instead of Norristown State Hospital unless there is a reason for a person to go on the wait list for Norristown.

We have 6 consumers involved in Veteran's Treatment Court and 10 consumers involved in Drug Treatment Court in Carbon County.

- **CASSP:**

There are 8 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 27 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 2 discharges and 4 recommendations for out of home placements.

- **CHIPP:**

There are currently 20 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).

There was 1 admission, 0 diversions, 2 discharges and 1 individual is on the waiting list.
