MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT**

April 2019

STAFFING:

The TCM Department has a vacancy in Carbon.

BUDGET:

No updates

PROVIDERS:

Person Centered Supports (PCS) will be ready for admissions in the next week for the Forensic SIL program. The Forensic CRR, located in Lansford, Carbon County will be ready for admissions within the next few weeks as soon as they are approved by OMHSAS.

Project Transitions is working on securing a location for the RTF-A (Residential Treatment Facility – Adult). It is a property that was a medical facility in Pocono Lake PA, Monroe County.

Pocono Alliance and the United Way have merged and is now Pocono Mountain United Way effective April 1.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

- **Administrative Case Management:**

47 CMP Intakes in March 2019 / 16 CMP walk-ins / 160 CMP Screening calls

- **Targeted Case Management:**

31 CMP Intakes in March 2019 and 26 discharges.

Carbon TCM continues to be closed for referrals with a projected opening by the end of April.

- **Forensic Department:**

18 CMP Intakes in March 2019

We currently have 8 individuals in Norristown and 3 individuals are in Torrance. We have 4 consumers on the wait list for admission.

We have 6 consumers involved in Veteran's Treatment Court and 14 consumers involved in Drug Treatment Court in Carbon County.

- **CASSP:**

There are 7 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 26 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 4 discharges and 5 recommendations for out of home placements.

- **CHIPP:**

There are currently 20 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).

There was 1 admission, 2 diversions, 1 discharge and 0 individuals are on the waiting list.
