

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT
MAY 2019**

STAFFING:

The TCM Department has one vacancy in Carbon. We have one Monroe ACM out on a leave.

BUDGET:

We will begin budget meetings with providers for the upcoming 19/20 fiscal year in May. During these meetings with each individual provider, we will discuss their current fiscal situation, program strengths and challenges, and their budget request moving forward. CCBH (Community Care Behavioral Health) and New Perspectives (our crisis provider) will join a portion of each meeting to discuss any updates and to build relationships because there has been a lot of changes.

Level funding in projected for fiscal year 19/20.

PROVIDERS:

Person Centered Supports (PCS) has started excepting admissions for the Forensic SIL program. The Forensic CRR, located in Lansford, Carbon County will be ready for admissions within the next few weeks as soon as they are approved by OMHSAS.

Project Transitions has secured a location for the RTF-A (Residential Treatment Facility – Adult). It is a property that was a medical facility in Pocono Lake PA, Monroe County.

LVHN Pocono is expanding their crisis beds from 2 to 5 and creating a separate, bubble type unit. They are making sure they add a space for law enforcement to do electronic involuntary commitments. They are starting to do a Columbia Suicide Screening with every individual coming in on an involuntary commitment.

Community Solutions, Inc. is providing Multisystemic Treatment in Monroe and Pike. This program helps at-risk adolescents improve their behaviors and reduce their possibility of being placed out of the home.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

We are working with all of our departments to be electronic and limit any type of paper documentation.

- **Administrative Case Management:**
We are working with Street To Feet to develop a way to provide mental health screenings, intakes, and linkages to resources and services to homeless individuals in the community where they are located.
- **Targeted Case Management:**
Carbon TCM continues to be closed for referrals with a projected opening by the end May.

- **Forensic Department:**
20 CMP Intakes in April 2019
We currently have 7 individuals in Norristown and 5 individuals are in Torrance. We have 0 consumers on the wait list for admission.
We have 6 consumers involved in Veteran's Treatment Court and 14 consumers involved in Drug Treatment Court in Carbon County.
- **CASSP:**
There are 6 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 30 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 2 discharges and 3 recommendations for out of home placements.
- **CHIPP:**
There are currently 20 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).
There was 0 admissions, 0 diversions, 0 discharges and 1 individual is on the waiting list.
