MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT  
JUNE 2019**

**STAFFING:**

The Mental Health Department is fully staffed at this time.

**BUDGET:**

We are currently holding budget meetings with providers for the upcoming 19/20 fiscal year. .  
Level funding in projected for fiscal year 19/20.

**PROVIDERS:**

Nothing new to report.

**DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:**

- **Administrative Case Management:**  
ACM Department completed 45 intakes; had 20 walk-ins; and 193 screening calls.
- **Targeted Case Management:**  
TCM Program is in compliance with Department regulations and received the approval letter for our license effective 7/1/2019 through 7/1/2020.  
Carbon is open for referrals. We have 93 individuals open with TCM in CMP.
- **Forensic Department:**  
13 CMP Intakes in May 2019  
We currently have 5 individuals in Norristown for competency restoration and 6 individuals are in Torrance, 3 for competency and 3 on a commitment for mental health treatment. We have 1 consumer on the wait list for admission to Torrance.  
We have 6 consumers involved in the Veteran's Treatment Court and 30 consumers involved in the Drug Treatment Court in Carbon County.
- **CASSP:**  
There are 7 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 25 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 5 discharges and 2 recommendations for out of home placements.
- **CHIPP:**  
There are currently 20 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).  
There was 0 admissions, 0 diversions, 0 discharges and 1 individual is on the waiting list.
