

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT
JULY 2019**

STAFFING:

The Mental Health Department is fully staffed at this time.

BUDGET:

Level funding for fiscal year 19/20.

PROVIDERS:

Merakey has started an open access walk in model for intake assessments on Monday's from 10 AM to 2 PM.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

- **Administrative Case Management:**

ACM Department completed 34 intakes; had 13 walk-ins; and 183 screening calls in June 2019.

- **Targeted Case Management:**

TCM Department received 50 referrals, completed 26 intakes and had 18 discharges in June 2019.

Forensic Department:

9 CMP Intakes in June 2019

We currently have 4 individuals in Norristown for competency restoration and 6 individuals are in Torrance, 3 for competency and 3 on a commitment for mental health treatment. We have 2 consumers on the wait list for admission to Torrance.

We have 5 consumers involved in the Veteran's Treatment Court and 20 consumers involved in the Drug Treatment Court in Carbon County.

- **CASSP:**

There are 7 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 25 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 1 discharge and 3 recommendations for out of home placements.

- **CHIPP:**

There are currently 17 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).

There was 0 admissions, 0 diversions, 3 discharges and 1 individual is on the waiting list.
