

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT
January 2020**

STAFFING:

Sean Connors, who was a Monroe TCM was promoted to the Forensic Coordinator position and will start in this new position on February 3, 2020. We are currently in the process of interviewing for two additional Forensic Case Management positions.

Jen Fuente our Community Outreach Coordinator and Tricia Baffa our Director of Consumer Supports have both been accepted into the CIT International, Inc.'s CIT Coordinator's Certification Course which will be held in August 2020.

Ellen Siegel has accepted the Per Diem TCM position that will be utilized in the event that a full time TCM is out for an extended period of time in order to remain in compliance with regulatory requirements.

BUDGET:

The budget is very tight this year and we are being very conservative with funds. We are meeting with our providers who we have contracts with for county funded services to come up with a plan to work within our contract caps.

PROVIDERS:

No updates at this time.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

- **Administrative Case Management:**

ACM Department completed 24 intakes; had 9 walk-ins; and 169 screening calls in December 2019.

- **Targeted Case Management:**

TCM Department received 33 referrals, completed 22 intakes and had 19 discharges in December 2019. The TCM Department and the Wellness Nurse met all of the requirements and the bonus for The Behavioral Health Home Plus Contract.

Forensic Department:

7 CMP Intakes in December 2019.

We currently have 2 individuals in Norristown for competency restoration and 1 for mental health treatment. We currently have 2 individuals in Torrance for competency restoration and 1 for mental health treatment. We do not have any individuals on the wait list for either State Forensic Treatment Center.

We have 5 consumers involved in the Veteran's Treatment Court and 13 consumers involved in the Drug Treatment Court in Carbon County.

- **CASSP:**

There are 11 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 28 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 1 discharge and 2 recommendations for out of home placements.

- **CHIPP:**

There are currently 14 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).

There was 1 admission, 0 diversions, 0 discharges and 0 individuals are on the waiting list.
