

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS  
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT  
March 2020**

**STAFFING:**

MH Department is in the processing of hiring a Forensic Case Manager.

**BUDGET:**

No updates.

**PROVIDERS:**

Wayne Woznikaitis has been cleared to enter all three of our correctional facilities and our team is already sending him referrals for incarcerated individuals to start the CBT groups. Pike and Carbon Correctional Facilities have closed their doors to visitors for now due to the coronavirus concerns so the implementation of the CBT Groups will be delayed. Wayne is beginning to work on an assessment for our teams to use when individuals are being referred for residential and mental health services. This will help us make sure that we are admitting them into the appropriate levels of services.

All providers have created plans to deal with the COVID 19 and are updating on an as needed basis as the situations in our communities are changing.

**DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:**

- **Administrative Case Management:**  
ACM Department completed 25 intakes; had 8 walk-ins; and 155 screening calls in February 2020.
- **Targeted Case Management:**  
TCM Department received 54 referrals, completed 32 intakes and had 35 discharges in February 2020. We are waiting to hear back regarding the recent FWA audit and we met with CCBH to discuss the Wellness contract for 2020. We have signed off on the contract and are beginning our assessments and tracking for the 2020 contract.
- **Forensic Department:**  
3 CMP Intakes in February 2020.  
We currently have 2 individuals in Norristown for competency restoration and 1 for mental health treatment. We currently have 1 individual in Torrance for competency restoration and 1 for mental health treatment. We do not have any individuals on the wait list for either State Forensic Treatment Center.  
We have 3 consumers involved in the Veteran's Treatment Court and 11 consumers involved in the Drug Treatment Court in Carbon County.
- **CASSP:**  
There are 9 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 26 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 3 discharges and 5 recommendations for out of home placements.
- **CHIPP:**  
There are currently 14 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).  
There was 0 admissions, 0 diversions, 0 discharges and 0 individuals are on the waiting list.
