

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT
MAY 2020**

STAFFING:

MH Department is in the process of developing a virtual training for two Forensic Case Managers who will be starting mid-May. We have a vacant TCM position.

BUDGET:

No updates.

PROVIDERS:

Our outpatient and partial providers are seeing an increase in utilization of services since starting telehealth options. Believe that this is related to eliminating transportation barriers and availability to participate because of being at home.

Residential providers are being creative working on strategies to keep individuals in the residences and doing activities as much as possible. We are only doing moves if it is an absolute necessity. These providers are being creative with staff to make sure that there is coverage and the least amount of transition as possible.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

- **Administrative Case Management:**

ACM Department completed 16 intakes and 56 screening calls in April 2020.

- **Targeted Case Management:**

TCM Department received 25 referrals, completed 23 intakes and had 17 discharges in April 2020.

- **Forensic Department:**

4 CMP Intakes in April 2020.

We currently have 4 individuals in Norristown; 2 for competency restoration, 1 for mental health treatment and 1 for both competency restoration and mental health treatment. We currently have 2 individuals in Torrance; 1 for competency restoration and 1 for mental health treatment. We have 2 individuals on the wait list for Norristown Forensic Treatment Center.

The Carbon Veteran's Treatment Court and Drug Treatment Courts have resume this month and we have 1 individual involved in VTC and 16 individuals involved in DTC.

- **CASSP:**

There are 12 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 27 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 1 discharge and 5 recommendations for out of home placement..

- **CHIPP:**

There are currently 12 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).

There was 0 admissions, 0 diversions, 1 discharge and 1 individual is on the waiting list.
