

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT
July 2020**

STAFFING:

MH Department has a vacant TCM position.

BUDGET:

5 month level funding budget.

PROVIDERS:

Most Providers are continuing to provide the majority of their services virtually. Face to face services are available if they are needed.

The Office of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (OMHSAS) has selected Carbon/Monroe/Pike joinder and Wayne county as recipients of the Community Mental Health Services Block Grant (CMHSBG) First Episode Psychosis (FEP) Program Site Grant. For FY 20-21 each team is projected to serve 20 consumers using the CSC model.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

- **Administrative Case Management:**

ACM Department completed 27 intakes and 160 screening calls in June 2020.

- **Targeted Case Management:**

TCM Department received 34 referrals, completed 18 intakes and had 23 discharges in June 2020.

TCM License renewal was approved for July 1, 2020 to July 1, 2021.

TCM Wellness program met all of their June goals regarding hypertension and smoking cessation.

- **Forensic Department:**

5 CMP Intakes in June 2020 and 3 re-entry plans for released individuals.

We currently have 7 individuals in Norristown, 5 for competency restoration and 2 for mental health treatment. We currently have 2 individuals in Torrance, 1 for competency restoration and 1 for mental health treatment. We have 2 individuals on the wait list for Norristown Forensic Treatment Center.

We have 1 consumer involved in the Veteran's Treatment Court and 16 consumers involved in the Drug Treatment Court in Carbon County. The treatment courts resumed in May and are being delivered by telehealth and in person to meet CDC guidelines due to COVID-19.

- **CASSP:**

There are 11 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 32 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There were 3 discharges and 3 recommendations for out of home placement.

- **CHIPP:**

There are currently 12 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).

There was 0 admissions, 0 diversions, 0 discharges and 1 individual is on the waiting list.
