

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT
August 2020**

STAFFING:

MH Department has a vacant FCM and TCM position.

BUDGET:

5 month level funding budget for the start of FY 20/21.

PROVIDERS:

Most Providers are continuing to provide the majority of their services virtually, however our providers for ACT, and TCM/BCM services are having face to face visits as needed.

September is National Suicide Prevention Month and September 10th is National Suicide Prevention Day. We are preparing and will be taking part in some efforts to bring awareness, including some spots on PA Live with WBRE/WYOU to promote awareness and education.

MH and DS Departments are working together and will be creating a few virtual events related to wellness for our staff and for our consumers.

We are working on increasing participation in our Community Support Program (CSP) meetings to make sure that consumers voices are heard and to assist them to develop, support, and participate in activities and events. We will be discussing the ideas of creating a virtual drop in platform and adding some activities to our CSP meetings.

We are discussing bringing back some warm line hours for our CMP individuals.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

- **Administrative Case Management:**
ACM Department completed 16 intakes and 150 screening calls in July 2020.
- **Targeted Case Management:**
TCM Department received 42 referrals, completed 27 intakes and had 26 discharges in July 2020.
- **Forensic Department:**
9 CMP Intakes in July 2020 and 8 re-entry plans for released individuals.
We currently have 8 individuals in Norristown, 6 for competency restoration and 2 for mental health treatment. We currently have 2 individuals in Torrance, 1 for competency restoration and 1 for mental health treatment. We have 0 individuals on the wait list for Norristown Forensic Treatment Center. We have 1 consumer involved in the Veteran's Treatment Court and 16 consumers involved in the Drug Treatment Court in Carbon County. The treatment courts resumed in May and are being delivered by telehealth and in person to meet CDC guidelines due to COVID-19.
- **CASSP:**
There are 10 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 33 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There were 3 discharges and 3 recommendations for out of home placement.
- **CHIPP:**
There are currently 12 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).
There was 0 admissions, 0 diversions, 1 discharge and 0 individuals are on the waiting list.
