

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS  
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT  
October 2020**

**STAFFING:**

No updates.

**BUDGET:**

We received our MH Allocation letter for FY 2020-21. The approved funding is for 5 months and the allocation totals could change pending the next approved budget. Infant & Early Childhood Mental Health Training for Behavioral Health Staff and Housing Related Training for county program staff and providers are both included in our Program Maintenance Funds again this year.

**GENERAL:**

We have several Mental Health First Aid and Question Persuade Refer Trainings scheduled. Our staff is delivering and participating in many virtual events to promote awareness and support. We are working on an event for some of our consumers who don't have many resources or supports and could benefit from some outreach during the holiday season.

**DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:**

- **Administrative Case Management:**  
ACM Department completed 28 intakes and 186 screening calls in September 2020.
- **Targeted Case Management:**  
TCM Department received 56 referrals, completed 25 intakes and had 28 discharges in September 2020.
- **Forensic Department:**  
6 CMP Intakes in September 2020 and 8 re-entry plans for released individuals.  
We currently have 9 individuals in Norristown, 8 for competency restoration and 1 for mental health treatment. We currently have 1 individual in Torrance for mental health treatment. We have 2 individuals on the wait list for Norristown Forensic Treatment Center.  
We have 4 consumers involved in the Veteran's Treatment Court and 42 consumers involved in the Drug Treatment Court in Carbon County.
- **CASSP:**  
There are 9 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 31 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There were 3 discharges and 4 recommendations for out of home placement.
- **CHIPP:**  
There are currently 11 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).  
There were 0 admissions, 2 diversions, 0 discharges and 0 individuals are on the waiting list.
