

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT
January 2021**

STAFFING

The MH Department has one Pike TCM open position.

BUDGET:

No updates.

GENERAL:

We are working with our residential providers to monitor staffing needs, vacancy, and Covid-19 emergency plans. We are also monitoring the access to the Covid-19 vaccine for our providers, the consumers, and their staff. Many of our providers are currently in the process of getting the consumers and staff vaccinated through their relationships with the pharmacies that they utilize on a regular basis.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

- **Administrative Case Management:**

ACM Department completed 21 intakes and 154 screening calls in December 2020.

- **Targeted Case Management:**

TCM Department received 48 referrals, completed 23 intakes and had 28 discharges in December 2020.

- **Forensic Department:**

12 CMP Intakes in December 2020 and 11 re-entry plans for released individuals.

We currently have 10 individuals in Norristown all for competency restoration. We currently have 1 individual in Torrance for mental health treatment. We have 0 individuals on the wait list for Norristown Forensic Treatment Center.

We have 4 consumers involved in the Veteran's Treatment Court and 41 consumers involved in the Drug Treatment Court in Carbon County.

Residential Treatment Facility – Adults: moving along with a projected ground breaking by the end of January. Very soft projected timeline for admissions will be around July 2021.

- **CASSP:**

There are 6 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 35 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There were 4 discharges and 5 recommendations for out of home placement.

- **CHIPP:**

There are currently 10 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).

There were 0 admissions, 0 diversions, 1 discharge and 0 individuals are on the waiting list. We have 4 Individuals in our Extended Acute Care program and 3 individuals on the wait list.
