MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT  
February 2021**

**STAFFING**

The MH Department has one Monroe TCM open position.

**BUDGET:**

No updates.

**GENERAL:**

Providers are continuing the process of getting the consumers and staff vaccinated through their relationships with the pharmacies that they utilize on a regular basis.

Warm Line Services are available to CMP residents again. The Warm Line is a confidential, non-crisis, one on one telephone service that supports individuals with a mental illness who may be experiencing loneliness or just need to talk.

HOPE, an early intervention program for adolescents and young adults experiencing their First Episode Psychosis is open for referrals. The Children's Service Center will be presenting this program and the referral process to our case management staff this month.

**DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:**

- **Administrative Case Management:**

ACM Department completed 24 intakes and 177 screening calls in January 2021.

- **Targeted Case Management:**

TCM Department received 42 referrals, completed 28 intakes and had 25 discharges in January 2021.

- **Forensic Department:**

12 CMP Intakes in January 2021 and 4 re-entry plans for released individuals.

We currently have 10 individuals in Norristown all for competency restoration. We currently have 1 individual in Torrance for mental health treatment. We have 0 individuals on the wait list for Norristown Forensic Treatment Center.

- **CASSP:**

There are 5 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 35 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There were 2 discharges and 5 recommendations for out of home placement.

- **CHIPP:**

There are currently 10 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).

There were 0 admissions, 0 diversions, 1 discharge and 0 individuals are on the waiting list. We have 4 Individuals in our Extended Acute Care program and 2 individuals on the wait list.
