

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT
July 2021**

STAFFING

The MH Department has one vacancy in the TCM Department, two in the FCM Department and we are still working on filling the additional Mental Health Administrative Assistant position. We are in the process of interviewing internal candidates for the Monroe CASSP Coordinator position.

BUDGET:

No updates.

GENERAL:

No updates.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

- **Administrative Case Management:**
ACM Department completed 19 intakes and 148 screening calls in June 2021.
- **Targeted Case Management:**
TCM Department received 39 referrals, completed 25 intakes and had 39 discharges in June 2021. Monroe TCM was not accepting referrals from June 21 to July 19. Pike TCM is still not at this time due to staff vacancies.
- **Forensic Department:**
18 CMP Intakes in June 2021 and 11 re-entry plans for released individuals.
The June census was 5 for Norristown for competency restoration and 0 for mental health treatment. There were 3 discharges in June. We currently have 1 individual in Torrance for mental health treatment. We have 0 individuals on the wait list for Norristown Forensic Treatment Center.
CMP is working with 4 individuals involved in Carbon Tx Court and 34 individuals involved in Carbon Drug Treatment Court.
- **CASSP:**
There are 6 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 34 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There were 4 discharges and 7 recommendations for out of home placement.
- **CHIPP:**
There are currently 11 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH).
There were 1 admission, 1 diversion, 0 discharges and 1 individual is on the waiting list.
We have 3 individuals in our Extended Acute Care program; have 2 authorizations pending and 1 person was diverted.
