MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT
October 2021**

STAFFING

The MH Department is currently interviewing for an administrative assistant, and we are setting up interviews for four Targeted Case Management and two Forensic Case Manager positions.

BUDGET:

No updates.

GENERAL:

We are planning and preparing for our annual holiday event. For the second year we are going to hold a drive through event to hand out resource information and a gift for at least 200 consumers from our agency. Donations from CCBH and some businesses in our community makes this possible.

The Residential Treatment Facility for Adults is nearing completion. As soon as the water suppression system is completed, and the licensing inspection and credentialing takes place they will be ready for admissions. We are currently working on three referrals for this program.

DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:

- **Administrative Case Management:**
ACM Department completed 26 intakes and 183 screening calls in September 2021.

- **Targeted Case Management:**
TCM Department received 12 referrals, completed 9 intakes and had 17 discharges in September 2021. Monroe and Pike TCM are closed for referrals at this time due to vacancies.

- **Forensic Department:**
CMP is working with 3 individuals involved in Carbon Veterans Treatment Court and 32 individuals involved in Carbon Drug Treatment Court.

- **CASSP:**
There are 7 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 36 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 5 discharges and 2 recommendations for out of home placement.

- **CHIPP:**
There are currently 11 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH). There were 0 admissions, 1 diversion, 0 discharges and 1 individual is on the waiting list. We have 4 individuals in our community based Extended Acute Care program; have 3 authorizations pending and 2 people were diverted. We have 4 CMP individuals in the hospital based EAC at St. Luke's Sacred Heart Campus and 1 individual on this wait list.
